Written by three sailing parents, who have each voyaged thousands of miles with children onboard, *Voyaging with Kids* provides a factual and balanced look at the realities of family life on the sea. From their own experience, as well as information drawn from interviews with dozens of other voyaging parents, they discuss caring for an infant onboard, handling the changing needs of children as they grow, education options, ensuring parents find the private time to keep their relationships in tune, and helping children make the eventual transition back to shore life. Added to the authors' voices are sidebars from other cruising parents with specialized information on subjects as diverse as handling special diets and how your children can keep in touch with friends around the world. A unique bonus chapter, written by a dozen former cruising kids, looks at the long-term effects of breaking away from shoreside normalcy. A substantial appendix of resources provides valuable further information on the subjects covered in this book.

Though Lin Pardey will be on hand at the US Sailboat Show and also the SSCA Gam to help introduce *Voyaging with Kids*, the three authors, each of whom has written many articles for sailing publications, cannot share the pleasure of launching their first book. Michael Robertson with his wife Windy and two kids are currently voyaging through the Pacific islands; Behan Gifford with her husband Jamie and three kids are headed toward Africa from Chagos Archipelago; and Sara Dawn Johnson is exploring the north of New Zealand with her husband Michael and two daughters.
